

7.c Form and date of most recent records or inventory of property

1. *Baden bei Wien*

AUSTRIA

The Construction-Authority (Stadtbaudirektion) and the municipal archive (c/o Rollett-museum) of the City of Baden keep records of the buildings and update them regularly. Also, the “Austrian Monuments Authority” (Bundesdenkmalamt, BDA, Department for Lower Austria) keeps relevant documents.

BELGIUM

Classified property

The Decree of 1 April 1999 on the conservation and protection of the heritage sets out these notions and the identification, protection, management and restoration procedures. Property in Wallonia can be classified if it is of historic, archaeological, scientific, artistic, social, technical, memorial, architectural, aesthetic, urban planning or landscape interest and if it meets the criteria of authenticity, integrity, rarity and representativeness. There are various types of classification: monument, architectural complex, site and archaeological site.

Within the boundaries, 25 properties are classified in accordance with the stipulations of the CoPat (Walloon Heritage Code). Of these, twenty are classified as monuments and five as sites.

The first classification dates back to 1934. It is now the current City Hall, but at the time was classified as an old middle school. Most other properties were classified in the 1970s and 1980s. The most recent classification is the old *Spa* cemetery in 2004.

Seven of these properties are privately owned and the other eighteen either belong to the town of *Spa* or to the Walloon Region or to public bodies.

Exceptional heritage

The Walloon Government draws up the list of the exceptional heritage in Wallonia every three years. The criteria adopted to select the properties take their inspiration directly from guidelines governing the list of the UNESCO world heritage.

The Walloon Government Order of 6 October 2016 lists 218 properties falling under the exceptional heritage of Wallonia, including three in *Spa*: the eighteenth century parts of the Waux-Hall, Gallery Léopold II in the Parc des Sept Heures and the former bathhouse.

Inventory of immovable cultural heritage (I.P.I.C.)

The Inventory describes the heritage inventory in the meaning of CoPat Art. 192. This assimilates and updates the previous inventories of the monumental heritage (1973 to 1997) and the Wallonia architectural and territory heritage (1998 to 2011). The inclusion of a property in the Inventory recognises its heritage quality at local level, unlike the

classification, which identifies the heritage quality of a property at regional level. The Inventory goals are knowledge, protection and management of included properties and raising public awareness. The Inventory was updated in *Spa* during the year 2016.

Remarkable trees and hedges

Over two hundred items found throughout the *Spa* municipal area are included on the list of remarkable trees and hedges of the Walloon Region Heritage. They include 117 isolated trees, 26 groups of trees, twenty hedges, 28 rows of trees, sixteen sites and two areas of hedges (19/09/2012).

Planning permission is required before any work may take place on these items: felling, harming the root system or changing the appearance of a remarkable tree or shrub or a remarkable hedge.

Inventory of areas of landscape interest and remarkable viewpoints

A component of the quality of life, bolstering the memory and identity of inhabitants, testifying to the cultural and ecological diversity of territories..., the landscape participates in the social well-being and constitutes a favourable resource for economic activity, mainly through tourism.

Initiated in 1992 and entrusted to the ADESA association by the Walloon Region, the inventory of areas of landscape interest and remarkable viewpoints addresses the identification of landscapes and views with an aesthetic quality that justifies their inclusion. The working methods call mainly for participation.

The landscape analysis was updated in *Spa* in December 2015 with the assistance of the Land Use Planning Municipal Commission (CCATM).

Inventory of the heritage of *Spa* – cultural centre

In 2006, the *Spa* Cultural Centre carried out an inventory entitled “*Spa*, standard bearer for European spas”. This list of typical features of spas found in *Spa* is the first document in the application by *Spa* for recognition as UNESCO World Heritage.

Inventory of villas built in *Spa* between the second half of the nineteenth century and the beginning of the twentieth century

Doctor of art history and archaeology, David Houbrechts, undertook an inventory of villas built in *Spa* between the second half of the nineteenth century and the beginning of the twentieth century. This work which was completed in June 2018 will help the city council to manage quarters of villas.

Scientific project: The great hours of *Spa*

Stéphane BLOND, Senior lecturer at the University of Evry-Val-D'essonne, leads an ongoing scientific project, “The great hours of *Spa*. A crossroads of Europe during the Age of Enlightenment” (visitor database, dynamic mapping, 3D reconstructions). The project is still in progress.

National archives and libraries

National Archive of the Czech Republic

The archival funds, New Manipulation, Old Czech Governorship and the extensive Czech Gubernium which mirror the development of political administration from twelfth century until the mid-nineteenth century are especially important to gain knowledge about the history of the components of the serial property. Other important archival funds are Old Manipulation – urbariums, estimates, inventories, collection of maps and plans, collection manuscripts and collection of art prints, drawings and paintings, where numerous historical vedute and maps are deposited. For the period 1848–1918 there are also deposited, among others, funds of civil engineering, culture and preservation of monuments.

National Technical Museum in Prague

The publicly accessible Archive of Architecture and civil engineering contains over 200 files documenting the development of architecture of the nineteenth and twentieth century. In addition to the estates of famous Czech architects or builders, it also includes several thematic collections concerning the history of architecture and civil engineering concerning also spa heritage. The archive offers diverse archive files for study purposes: drawings, sketches, studies, plans, photographs, personal documents, etc.

Archives and Library of the National Heritage Institute – Directorate General

In the archives and libraries of the National Heritage Institute there are professional publications on the preservation of monuments, history of art, architecture, urbanism, archaeology, conservation and restoration of monuments. The National Heritage Institute provides various researches and building documentation, before and after building activity, and also during repairs and restoration of these buildings. Besides this operational documentation, standard building historical researches are conducted, which are deposited in the collection of plans, building historical researches and restoration reports. Reports from researches are collected in archives of the individual regional offices of the National Heritage Institute. Regarding heritage conservation, other documentation is also important for town planning, especially development plans including drawing documentation of the individual towns.

Records of intangible cultural monuments in the Central Registry of Cultural

Properities of the Czech Republic

Records of over 50 intangible cultural monuments listed in the Central Registry of Cultural Properities of the Czech Republic, which are situated on the area of the Czech component parts and their buffer zones, are deposited in the Directorate General of the National Heritage Institute in Prague. The records contain brief files with identification of the locality (location, name, marking, owner, dating) and its description. Parts of the records also are an evaluation of heritage importance and the condition of a monument with provisions for its protection, literature and other documentation references (for example photographic and surveying documentation). In addition, the file contains

photographic documentation and cadastral maps specifying the extent of the locality.

Regional level

Library of balneology

The regional library of *Karlovy Vary* administers the unique fund of historic literature on balneology. Currently the library contains over 1,700 books in the so called historic fund and further, more than 500 newly purchased current documents with balneological and medical themes. The oldest and rare prints as well as works by regional authors and medical textbooks are represented here.

State Regional Archive in Plzeň – State District Archive Karlovy Vary and Cheb

The state district archive *Karlovy Vary* also contains funds regarding spa heritage, for example the fund of political administration, especially district political reports after 1850, funds of municipalities' administration, health facilities, cultural and scientific facilities and building administration. Spa towns' building plans are also deposited here. Archive funds for Mariánské Lázně and Františkovy Lázně are deposited in the State district archive in Cheb.

Building authorities' archives

The most important archive materials concerning buildings in spa towns are preserved in the archives of the individual building authorities. There are materials of building agenda concerning building permissions including architectural drawings and plans of the individual buildings and urban complexes.

Museums, medical spa companies' archives

Further important archive materials and a number of publications, maps and photographic documentation are also deposited in museums of the individual spa towns and archives of spa companies.

Municipalities' development plans

Documentation and terrain surveys are also a part of the development plans of the individual component parts of the nominated property. Besides the textual part containing analysis of the condition and development of the region and analysis of its sustainable development, the development plan also contains a graphical part including the main drawing and also the conception of landscape structuring, a conception of public infrastructure and other detailed drawings usually at the scale of 1 : 5,000. All component parts of the nominated property have valid development plans.

Archival material

Historic documents on the history of the town and spa of *Bad Ems* are kept in the municipal museum and archive and listed in a digital database.

Library

The municipal archives have a library with nearly all books and publications on *Bad Ems*, including historical literature on balneology from the sixteenth to twentieth century. They are listed in a digital database.

The register lists and maps all trees existing in the Kurpark. It gives information on tree species and damages.

Historic documents on the history of the town and spa of *Baden-Baden*

There are 186,000 items listed on the digital database “Augias“ at the municipal museum and archive *Baden-Baden*.

Monument list *Baden-Baden*, continually updated

There are 1,329 historic buildings, monuments and small-sized monuments listed in *Baden-Baden* under Monument Protection Law. The list is continually updated in the state-wide databank (ADAB-Web) by the State Office for the Preservation of Historical Monuments based on research and the actual condition of the monuments.

Cadastral tree register, continually updated

The cadastral tree register lists and maps all trees existing on communal grounds, including the spa parks and gardens. It gives information on tree species, extent of bole and any damages. However there is no list on private trees in mansion gardens or hotel gardens. The register is kept at the department of parks and gardens of the municipality of *Baden-Baden*.

Cadastral register of maintenance of green spaces, continually updated

List of all objects of maintenance within the green spaces: benches, litters, paths, beds, lawns etc. The register is kept at the department of parks and gardens of the municipality of *Baden-Baden*.

List and survey of the elements of the spa landscape of *Baden-Baden*, 2017

The town of *Baden-Baden* has commissioned an architect's office for the documentation of historic elements of the spa landscape of *Baden-Baden* in 2017. The aim is to list and explain the diverse elements such as paths, crosses, stones, benches etc. deriving from the development of the landscape in course of its formation as a world spa town.

List of historic grave sites at the town cemetery, 2012

Documentation and descriptions of around 100 gravesites of the historic town cemetery where important and significant persons and families of the history of *Baden-Baden* are buried. The list is now closed and kept at the state office for the preservation of historical monuments.

List of small-sized monuments, *Baden-Baden*, 2005

13 staff members of the State office for the preservation of historical monuments and partner institutions have been documented around 650 small-sized monuments in the region of *Baden-Baden* from 2002 to 2005. The list is now closed. It is kept at the municipal archive *Baden-Baden* and the state office for the preservation of historical monuments. More information on www.kleindenkmale-bw.de.

Ortskernatlas Baden-Württemberg. Stadt und Stadtkreis *Baden-Baden*, 1993

The atlas of the town centre was published in hard copy by the State office for the preservation of historical monuments and displays the history of settlement of the urban

and architectural development of the town from antiquity to present. Information is given on the basis of texts, aerial views, pictures and photographs. Maps provide a significant presentation of the building and urban structure. Historic map sheets compared to recent ones are able to depict changes.

Bad Kissingen's built monuments and archaeological monuments are listed in the Bavarian Denkmalliste, an inventory of all known built monuments, archaeological monuments as well as movable monuments. This list is compiled for informational purposes.

This report examines the area of the property and its surroundings in terms of urban heritage conservation. Beyond monuments this paper depicts the vast number of preserved outstanding historic architectural ensembles, great edifices and historical green spaces relevant to the character of the city's historic urban pattern. Furthermore the authors point out and describe disruptions of the designed urban pattern.

Alexandra Nadler, Entwicklung und Bestand der Kurlandschaft von *Bad Kissingen* in historisch-geographischer Sicht. Masterarbeit im Master-Studiengang Kulturgeographie. Friedrich-Alexander-Universität Erlangen-Nürnberg, Institut für Geographie, Erlangen 2014

Inventory of the elements of the cultural landscape which derive from the long nineteenth century and lay within the close surroundings of *Bad Kissingen*. This master thesis aims to identify the spa landscape's role and function to the spa business itself and furthermore to detect the historic elements which used to characterize the landscape and which of them are still preserved today. Studied elements are promenades, viewing points, pavilions and shelters, lookout towers, restaurants for excursionists as well as general points of attraction (built monuments, ruins, natural sights etc.).

10. *Montecatini Terme*

ITALY

The whole site, as well as individual territories that compose it, has been subject of numerous studies and publications, as can be seen from the substantial bibliography (Chapter 7.e). There are also some databases and catalogues relating to the components, which are summarized below.

As for the Italian cultural heritage, the Superintendence for archaeology, fine arts and landscape (local detachments of the Ministry for Cultural Heritage and Activities) operate in the areas of the Italian components, and have paper and digital inventories related to movable and immovable property under constraint protection. The record cards, differently structured according to the different types of assets, are processed in line with the national standards defined by the Central Institute for Cataloguing and Documentation of the Ministry (<http://www.iccd.beniculturali.it>).

In Italy, there are conservation institutes operating at the local level; a large amount of documents is also kept in the civic museums and municipal libraries, each one possessing inventories heritage of their own city and, more broadly, the documents relating to the fortresses of the Adriatic.

Another activity of filing of historical artistic property belonging to ecclesiastical entities is carried out by CEI (Italian Episcopal Conference). The activity of filing, the first essential step for the protection of the cultural heritage of a territory, gives an account of the spread of the historical and artistic heritage, as well as its importance.
